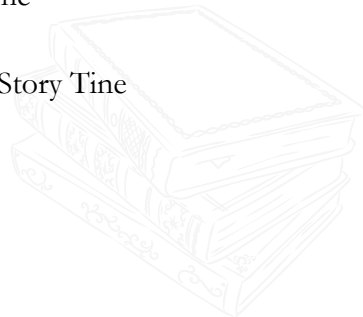

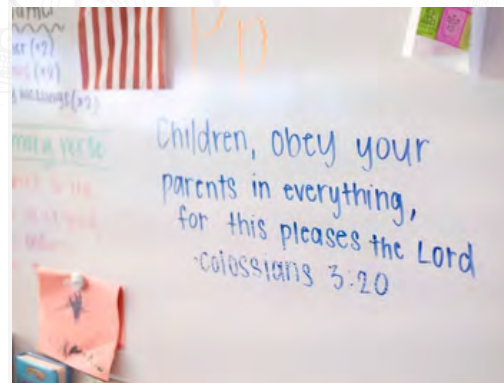
- Half-Day Enrollment: 8:00am - 12:00pm

Curriculum

Young Knights Preschool utilizes the five-day Memoria Press Junior Kindergarten and Preschool curriculum as the foundation for daily lessons and activities.

Our experienced educators also provide their own creative and beautiful activities, such as craft activities, sensory centers, and theme-based learning opportunities.

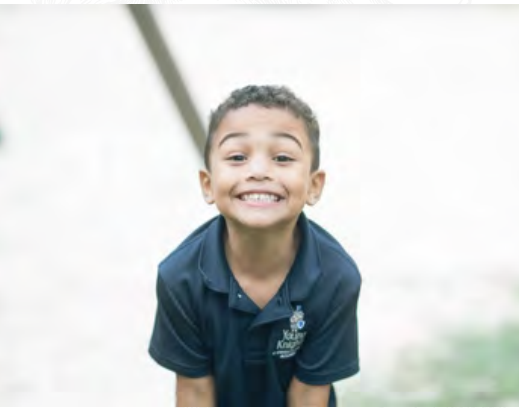


Student Work

In addition to daily lessons, we seek to engage students in all 8 developmental domains: physical development, approaches to learning, social and emotional development, language and literacy, mathematical thinking, scientific inquiry, social studies, and creative expression through the arts. Each class enjoys weekly visits from an art instructor and music instructor.

Three developmental assessments are administered for each student at the beginning, middle and end of the school year to track growth and to document precious milestones throughout these sweet years. Assessment books are gifted to families following the school year.
